- All registration is done at the WML Office.
- NON-REFUNDABLE \$100.00 deposit and \$25 registration fee are due at time of registration.
- A 3% convenience fee will be added for payments made by credit/debit cards.
- Parent must sign a waiver of liability for bodily injuries & a Covid Waiver at time of registration, as well as provide your child's birth certificate if they have not been previously enrolled.
- POA dues must be current.
- Any withdrawal of a child from a class MUST be done by a written letter to the POA office.
- Payment plans are available.
- First half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before **July 27th, 2024**. If first half payment is not received, child will not be allowed to start the first day of school.
- Second half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before **October 26th, 2024.** If second half payment is not received by October 26th, a \$50.00 late fee will be assessed.
- Monthly payments may be made as long as all tuition is paid in full no later than October 26th, 2024. Please contact the POA office to set up or make monthly payments.

You will also be able to register for Payment Plans based on when you register. There will no longer be an EARLY BIRD / REGULAR / LATE fee schedule for enrollment.

Sign up in January and choose a Monthly or Bi-Weekly Payment Plan. If you choose to pay by Credit Card, the system will break up your total registration amount by the number of payments selected and charge your card on those dates. If you choose to pay by check or cash, you will receive invoice reminders the week before your next payment is due to have checks or cash dropped off to the office.

For Teen Travel (TT) – the trip schedule is already booked, and you will see the trips listed by each week for registration.
