### FISH TALES

White Meadow Lake is putting on a variety show and I'm not talking about people singing and dancing! The lake is on fire producing different size and different species of fish waiting to attack your bait! This time of year as the water begins to warm up and fish look for cooler water during the day the thermocline is an aspect to pay attention to.

The best way to describe it would be if you went swimming at any of WML beach and as you get out into the deeper water you feel cool water towards the bottom and warmer water towards the top. What you're feeling is the thermocline and fish are affected by it.

The Thermocline is a small area of water that lies between the warm surface water and the deeper water that also holds little oxygen. Most of the time this small area of water is only about three feet from top to bottom. In a shallow lake like WML there are sometimes exceptions to this rule. WML depths really don't go over 11 feet and the Thermocline area is smaller than deeper lakes.

In mid-summer largemouth bass and other game fish will generally hold close to cover and/or structure near the upper edges of the Thermocline. When an angler finds the Thermocline this is great starting point for the proper depth to locate bass. A depth finder with the sensitivity turned up makes the Thermocline visible on the display. It will look like a false bottom reading on the display.

I like to use baits that fish the mid water depth like Chatterbaits, Spinnerbaits and Swimbaits to target the upper levels of the Thermocline. Keep It Reel,






