SYNOPSIS OF JANUARY BOARD MEETING

- Approved December 15, 2021 Board Meeting minutes.
- Approved motion to contract with Nisivoccia LLP, to provide Country Club financial auditing services & tax preparation for the 2021 fiscal year as described in their engagement letter, for an amount up to \$17,800. This includes the price quote of \$16,800 & a contingency amount of \$1,000 for potential additional work & fees. Money to come from Country Club.
- Approved motion to contract with Nisivoccia LLP, to provide POA financial auditing & tax preparation services for the 2021 fiscal year as described in their engagement letter, for an amount up to \$24,000. This includes the price quote of \$22,750 & a contingency amount of \$1,250 for potential additional work & fees. Money to come from line 513.03.
- Hired Tops Mailroom, Southdata, Inc to print & mail out the POA dues statements at a cost of \$2,649.74. Money to come from line 513.01.
- To unencumber the remaining amount (\$6,400) not used from the Equalization Fund for the House Ops motion from July & October regarding the ballroom a/c system & dog house on the roof.
- Approved motion to hire Travis Hubert as Director for 2022 Camp White Meadow season at salary discussed in closed caucus.
- Approved motion to hire Meghan Mattison as Assistant Director for the 2022 Camp White Meadow season at salary discussed in closed caucus.
- Approved motion to purchase two new dock sections from Custom Docks at a cost up to \$10,662.50, including tax. Funding to come from line 505.01.
- Hired Process Equipment Sales & Service to repair the duplex pump at beach 2 at a cost of \$842.12. Money to come from line 522.12.
- Motion to hire Guscus Landscaping LLC to replace the Drum Pool wall and renovate/remediate the pool deck at a cost not to exceed \$100,000. Money to come Equalization Fund. VOTE NEXT MONTH.
- Approved motion to hire NJ Mechanical to service bar/ kitchen equipment at a cost of \$1,706 including tax. Money to come from line 517.04 & will not overspend the line.
- Purchased two laptops from Dell Technologies for the office at a cost of \$3,236.03. Money to come from the 2021 budget line 513.10.
- Approved motion to accept the WML Rules Enforcement Policy.
- Approved motion to accept D&M Fireworks to provide our fireworks display for Festival Day on July 17, 2022, in the amount of \$7,475. If necessary, rain date will be July 24th. Money to come from Country Club.

BOATING RULES & REGULATIONS*

All DUES & FINES must be paid in full to obtain a White Meadow Lake 2022 Boat Tag.

- NJ DMV BOAT REGISTRATION & BOAT SAFETY CERTIFICATE are required for GAS & ELECTRIC powered boats to apply for a boat tag.
- BOAT, TRAILER & MOTOR SIZE- Boat & Trailer Length & Width are required. Maximum boat length-16 ft. Maximum Horse Power- 9.9 HP
- ONLY 2 BOATS PER RACK are allowed.
- OCCUPY DATE- Assigned space(s) must be occupied on May 31, for both dock and land.
- Spaces not occupied on May 31 may be reassigned upon a resident's request for the vacant space. The Office will contact the vacant space holder to advise them reassignment will be done, if after one week the space is not occupied. Extenuating circumstances will be considered if reported to the office.
- NO Waiting List will be maintained.
- Residents may SWAP SPACES after notifying the office and obtaining a replacement boat tag for the new space assigned.
- BOAT TAGS must be displayed or POA Security may padlock the boat until the proper tag is visible.
- HANDICAP accessible boat spaces will be available at all locations. A NJ state issued Handicap ID is required.
- CLEAN both your boat and trailer after it has been in another body of water before putting it back into WML.
- REMOVAL DATES- All Boats & trailers must be removed from WML property no later than November 7 or the resident will incur a \$100 fine per boat, in addition to a \$10 penalty per boat/per day.
