## SYNOPSIS OF NOVEMBER BOARD MEETING

- Approved motion to reinstate Mark Kempner to fill the Past President position.
- Approved motion to rescind motion #2 passed on 9/18/2019, where the board agreed to offset dues by \$320,000 from surplus funds.
- Approved motion to move \$137,000 into the Capital Improvement Fund from surplus funds.
- Approved motion to move \$137,000 into the Sinking Fund from surplus funds.
- Approved motion to set the 2020 POA dues at \$715 per home & \$178.75 per lot.
- Approved motion to hire Markovski Landscaping to restructure the Clubhouse lawn to prevent flooding at a cost not to exceed \$15,407.31. Money to come from 2020 budget line 517.06.

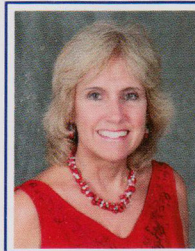


