October Board Meeting

- Approved Board Meeting minutes from September 17, 2025.
- BEACH: Defeated motion to hire Kompan to supply and install new playground equipment at Beach 3. Total cost not to exceed \$77,000. This includes the removal of old equipment. Money to come from the Country Club Reserve Fund.
- HOUSE OPS: Phone Vote- Approved motion to hire Maximum Fire Escapes to repair the Clubhouse fire escape and supply certificate for Rockaway Township at a cost not to exceed \$4,000.00. Money to come from line 517.04 and will not overspend the line.
- BOARD: Vote to fill the director's seat.
- LAKE & LAKE REC: Approved motion to purchase 6 boxes of Flock Logs (4 pond logs per box) plus freight of \$187.37 from Applied Polymer Systems, Inc. at a cost of \$2,707.37. Money to come from line 521.01.
- ATHLETICS: Approved motion to hire All Quality Fence Company for no more than \$5,000 from line 501.12 (Maintain Athletics Facilities). This will not overspend the line.
- ATHLETICS: Approved motion to purchase 30 tons of beam clay from Partac Peat Corporation at a cost not to exceed \$4,500 (includes delivery & sales tax). Money to come from line 501.12 (maintain athletic facilities).
- BAR & RENTAL: Approved motion to hire Barresi The Upholster LLC to provide new cushions including back and arm rests for the bench seating in the Trophy Room, Gold Lounge, Tiffany Bar, 1st floor landing and to upholster the two wing back chairs in the lobby at a cost not to exceed \$5,500 (tax included). Monies to come from Country Club.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: Approved motion to approve use of Humanitix Ticketing Platform on a trial basis for a period of 90 business days. No costs to POA aside from standard convenience and merchant fees.
- WOMEN'S CLUB FYI: Hiring Santa Thomi and Mrs. Claus for the preschool Santa event at a cost of \$1,000. Money to come from the preschool checkbook account.
- HOUSE ACTIVITIES: Approved motion to hire J&M Catering for the WML Holiday Party at a cost not to exceed \$3,000. Monies to come from Country Club.
- HOUSE ACTIVITIES: Approved motion to hire Jacques Exclusive Caterers for New Year's Eve at a cost of \$2,150.37. Cost to be covered by ticket price based on the sale of 65 tickets. Money to come from Country Club ticket sales. Cost subject to change (increase) based on ticket sales.
- MAINTENANCE: Approved motion to hire Markovski Tree Service to remove 3 trees at Beach 3. Money to come from line 525.02 not to exceed \$2,300 and will not overspend the line.

Please complete your registration by going through all of the steps prompted.

- A 3% convenience fee will be added for payments made by credit/debit cards.
- Parent must sign a waiver of liability for bodily injuries at time of registration, as well as provide your child's birth certificate if they have not been previously enrolled.
- POA dues must be current.
- Any withdrawal of a child from a class MUST be done by a written letter to the POA office.
- If you choose to pay via cash or check, you must do so in the office within 7 business days of completing your registration or forfeit

For 2025-26 School Year:

- NON-REFUNDABLE \$100.00 deposit and \$25 registration fee are due at time of registration.
- Payment plans are available.
- First half of the annual tuition fee was due on or before July 26th, 2025. If the first half payment is not received, the child will not be allowed to start the first day of school.
- Second half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before November 22nd, 2025. If second half payment is not received by November 22nd, a \$50.00 late fee will be assessed.
- Monthly payments may be made via the Campsite portal as long as all tuition is paid in full no later than November 22nd, 2025. If you are paying via cash or check, you can coordinate monthly payment directly with the office. 
