IMPORTANT CHANGE IN OUTSIDE LINE LOCATION!

To keep the Clubhouse front entry way clear for events, the boat registration line will form in the Beach 1 parking lot area and proceed to the dam bridge where numbers will be handed out by WML Security between 9:00 am and 12:30 pm on all 3 registration days. First person in the physical line will receive card #1, second in line card #2, etc.

Normal office business will be conducted all three days.

- Approved motion to hire Travis Hubert as the Camp Director for the 2020 summer season at a salary discussed in closed caucus. Money to come from Country Club Camp budget.
- Approved motion to hire Meghan Mattison as the Assistant Camp Director for the 2020 summer season at a salary discussed in closed caucus. Money to come from Country Club Camp budget.
- Approved motion to enter into a contract with Nisivoccia LLP, to provide Country Club financial auditing services for the 2019 fiscal year as described in their engagement letter, for an amount up to \$17,050. Money to come from Country Club.
- Approved motion to enter into a contract with Nisivoccia, LLP, to provide POA financial auditing services for the 2019 fiscal year as described in their engagement letter, for an amount up to \$23,100.
- Approved motion to hire Tom Harty Construction to replace the doors between the Gold Lounge & the Gold Bar at a cost of \$3,870. Money to be paid out of Country Club.
- FYI Hired El Mejicano to supply food for Latin Dance Night on February 22 at a cost of \$821.01. Money to come from Country Club Scholarship Fund ticket sales.
- FYI Hired Dixon Energy Inc to replace the circuit board on the furnace of the preschool building at a cost of \$1,150. Money to come from Country Club.
- Approved motion to purchase 276 trout from Musky Trout Hatcheries for the 2020 fishing season at an amount to not exceed \$2,577.39.
- FYI Hired Party Man Rentals for a rock wall on Friday, 7/17/20 of Festival Weekend at a cost of \$1,198. Money to come from Country Club.
- Approved motion to hire VP Security to install 6 additional cameras in the Clubhouse, in the bathroom hallways downstairs and upstairs lobby, and both ballrooms as well as Tiffany Lounge at a cost not to exceed 3,100.
- Approved motion for services from Garden State Laboratories to test the water at our four lake sites & the drum pool for the 2020 summer season at a cost of \$3,545.
- FYI Hiring Garden State Laboratories to test the water at the Circus pool for the 2020 summer season at a cost of \$1,300. \$325 to come from POA and \$975 to come from Country Club/Camp.
- Approved motion to hire Jimmy Concrete to install steps at the Drum pool gazebo from the swimming pool back gate to the gazebo at a cost of \$14,000.
- Approved motion to approve the expenditure of \$1,620.70 including sales tax for the annual maintenance contract for the POS system. This covers the whole system: 3 terminals, 3 printers, 3 cash drawers & software updates of the future POS application for 1 year. Money to come from Country Club.
- Approved motion to hire Window Rama to replace windows in the Clubhouse building at a cost of \$38,698 plus \$110 per hour + materials for any additional carpentry work. Lakefront homeowners also need a boat tag(s) even if you're not using a POA space. When you go to the office to pay your dues or just stop by, ask for a boat tag for all your watercraft. Any other members that have kayaks or canoes that you just bring onto the beach and launch also need a boat tag. They will be checking stickers at the gates and security will also be checking on the lake. Please remember that everything that goes down the storm drains end up in the lake so please clean up any debris or recycling that seems to blow around the neighborhood before it ends up in the lake. Rockaway Township works with us to clean the streets and storm drains early in the season to help prevent road gravel from ending up in the lake. The days are getting longer and the weather will be getting nicer so stop by the Clubhouse and enjoy the deck on nice days. Women's Club is having a fundraiser on the 14th and will be having a baking contest; You can stop by and watch and taste some items with a ticket.

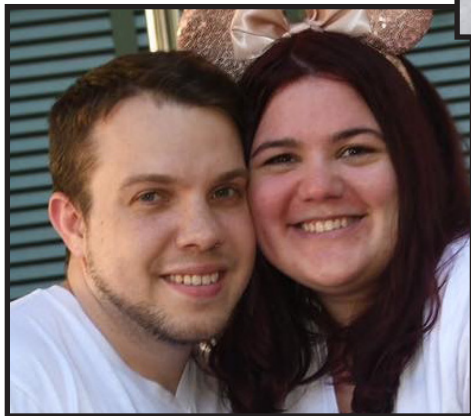

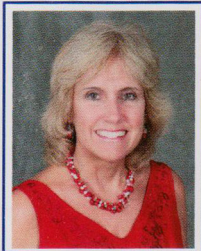

SEAS BASIC SAILING CLASS

Announcing 2020 Sailing Lessons

FOR ADULTS AND YOUTH AGES 9 AND UP

In the SEAS Basic Sailing Class, our instructors will take you from landlubber to seafarer through hands-on sailing experience and classroom sessions. In the classroom, you'll learn the fundamental knowledge necessary for getting started on a sailboat, from knots to terms to sailing theory, and then you'll be taken out on the water to apply your new knowledge and develop your sailing skills in a real-life, supervised, nautical setting.

Course includes 4 classroom sessions and 2 water sessions.

June 16, 18, 23, and 25 are classroom sessions and are held at the WML Clubhouse from 7:30 to 9:15 pm.

June 20 and 27 are water sessions hosted at BUDD LAKE on SEAS.

Lessons are taught by instructors from the Society for the Education of the American Sailor (SEAS) Morris club. Included in the course fee is a membership to the SEAS Morris, which becomes active upon completion of the course. Graduates of the course will also receive a certificate for completing the Basic Sailing coursework. Membership to SEAS Morris offers opportunities to practice sailing skills on Budd Lake using the SEAS sailboats.

Sign up and pay by check at the POA Office. Registration ends May 30.

WML Members in good standing \$200. All other students \$225. Registration includes 2019 membership to SEAS Morris.

NOTE – Youth under age 18 must be supervised by an adult at all times. The adult doesn't have to register and pay for the course but if they want to participate in any way (knot tying, water sessions) they need to register and pay. SEAS instructors recommend a person is at least 85 lbs to manage the sunfish sailboats independently, however SEAS instructors are willing to work with any youth ages 9 and up so long as they have the motivation to learn and can actively participate in all classroom and water sessions.

SWIM SKILLS: All participants must be able to swim and tread water over their head without a floatation device. Each person needs to bring their own "PFD" Personal Floatation Device otherwise known as a Life Preserver.

Please note - A supervising (non-paying) parent/guardian will need to be present for all classroom and water sessions for children under 18.

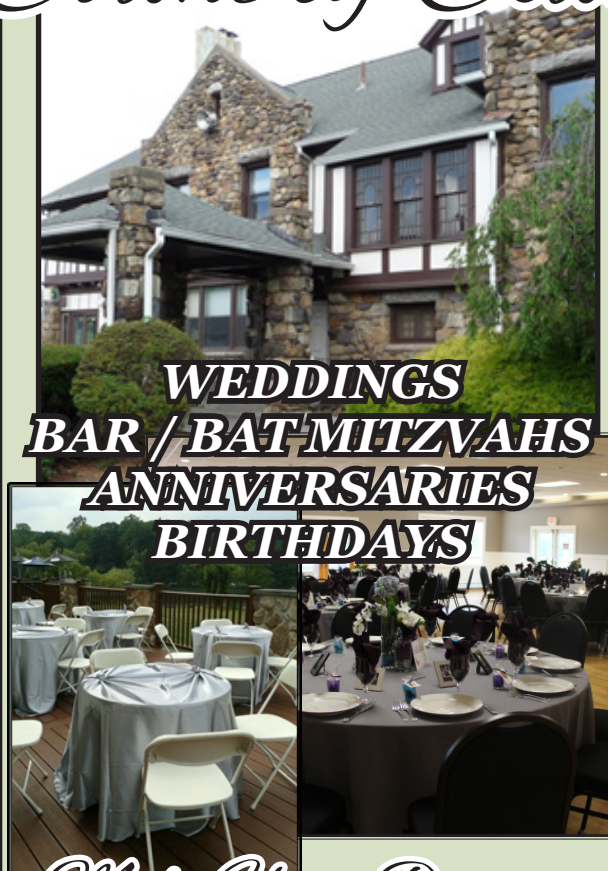
