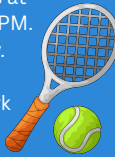


ADULT ROUND ROBIN

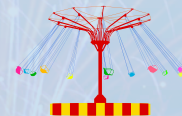



Despite the rainy and dreary weather on May 23, the White Meadow Lake Fishing Club hosted a lure making event. We had about 22 kids join in the fun and made spinning lures with help from Club Members.

Fishing Club Members had the opportunity to tour Musky Trout Hatchery, whom we have historically purchased our trout from for the Spring Stocking. Musky Trout Hatchery is the oldest privately owned fish farm in New Jersey, established in 1958, and located in Asbury, NJ. We were able to tour the system of raceways and circular tanks supplied by on-site springs to spawn, hatch, and grow trout as well as view their production of warm-water fish such as bluegill, bass, and crappie. After the tour, members went to a local diner for breakfast. It was great!

Remember to stop by the Fishing Club tent during Festival Weekend to see our displays of the fish in our lake. It is a fun and educational way for people to be up close to the fish. Also during Festival Weekend, we will host our next contest on July 18. This is the annual Festival Weekend Kids contest. The longest fish of any species (except carp) and most fish caught between 8am and 10:30am will take home a prize.

A Message from the Lake & Lake Reclamation Committee

To maintain optimal water quality and safety, White Meadow Lake requires all boaters to follow specific lake management guidelines. Please stow sails and Bimini tops while docked, secure vessels with two mooring lines, use only mushroom anchors, avoid aerators, and stay vigilant before or after storms. Adhering to these community and township guidelines helps preserve the lake's ecosystem and ensures safe navigation for all residents:

At the Dock: Always keep sails and Bimini tops stowed while your boat is docked. Ensure your vessel is adequately secured using at least two mooring lines to prevent drifting.

Anchoring: Use only mushroom-type anchors. Make sure to raise them completely every time the boat is moved to avoid damaging the lake bed and underwater equipment.

Weather Precautions: Check on your boat before and after any severe storm event to ensure mooring lines are intact and the boat is not taking on water.

Aerator Warning: Keep a safe distance from all lake aerators (bubblers). These are vital for maintaining water quality and can cause issues if disturbed.

Compliance & Reporting: Ensure your boat is properly registered, displays current tags, and report any hazards or issues you see while on the water.

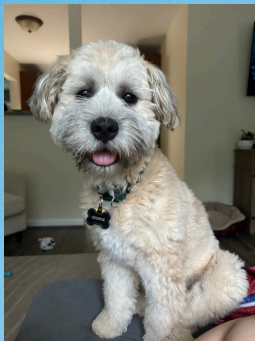
