6. Fish Study or Fishing Club Creel Project?

• Fish Study:

- i. Concerns with selecting species and quantities using data that is 17 years old.
- ii. Some people claim fishing has never been better, others claim it is not as good as it used to be.
- iii. Called NJ Fish & Game and spoke to someone in Freshwater Fisheries. They support both Creel Report and Survey, however, mortality rate for survey is less than 5%. Usually mortality rate using Seine nets, Traps, and electroshocking is closer to 1% if done during the cooler months. Mortality for gill netting is 50-75% so we absolutely DO NOT WANT TO USE GILL NETS.
- iv. Creel Report is helpful to see what is actually being caught, but won't tell you the overall health of the fishery-people aren't catching fingerlings.
- v. Cost is \$12,000.

• Fishing Club Creel Project

- i. Concern: not enough participants and can't control the data collection. Not enough info.
- ii. Current Creel Survey on QR code asks too many questions. Survey will be revised to have one question-what did you catch? Uploading a photo is optional.
- iii. Controlled data collection has 0 mortality rate and it can be a good representation of the health of the fishery. Must be same time of day, using the same lure.
- iv. Cost effective

VOTE results: Fishing Club voted unanimously to NO FISH STUDY at this time. Fishing Logbooks may be purchased for all active Fishing Club Members to participate in this effort. Data needs to be collected: date, time, weather, temperature, species, size, method. Free online apps are also available.
