

March Board Meeting

- Approved Board Meeting minutes from February 21, 2024.
- HOUSE OPS PHONE VOTE: Approved motion to purchase 32 LED lights and 16 bullhorn brackets from Cooper Electric taking advantage of the JCP&L rebate program for the replacement of the lights out of the tennis court project. The net cost after rebates are up to \$18,853.35. Total cost before rebates is \$27,253.35. Money to come from the Capital Improvement Fund-tennis ballot question.
- HOUSE OPS PHONE VOTE: Approved motion to hire Baptist Electric Inc to replace and update to LED lights all tennis and basketball lights and controls as per contract for up to \$16,000. Money to come from approved Capital Improvement Fund ballot question for tennis court project.
- BEACH: Approved motion to approve spending up to the line limit to California Beach Hut line 503.15 not to exceed \$5,500.00.
- BEACH: Approved motion to purchase up to 195 tons of beach sand from Silva/Sahara for a total price not to exceed \$7,000. Monies to come from line 503.02; this will not overspend the line.



Mandatory Winter PFD Wear Campaign

New Regulation 13:82-1.4(f): No owner or operator of a recreational vessel less than 26 feet, including rowboats, canoes, kayaks, and stand-up paddleboards shall permit its operation between November 1st and May 1st, unless each person on board such vessel is wearing a securely fastened United States Coast Guardapproved wearable personal flotation device of an appropriate size while such vessel is underway. A person inside the cabin of a cabin vessel shall be exempt from this requirement.

Swim Lessons



2024 SWIM LESSONS REGISTRATION & POLICIES

REGISTRATION: Begins May 4th at 9:00AM and ends May 30th at 5:00PM. This year, all registrations will be done online. The link for a new family registration is:

https://campwhitemeadow.campmanagement.com/enroll. It is recommended to create a family registration / child information in advance to save time in registering for classes when registration opens. When registering, enter your child's AGE - and based on that - only the classes that the child is eligible for will show up. You can choose to pay online via CC or by check at the office after registering online.

ATTENDANCE & ATTIRE - Please arrive at your child's class on time. Arriving late disrupts the flow of classes currently in session. Have swimmers ready in bathing suits and goggles. Please pick up promptly at the end of the scheduled class. Swimmers who are not toilet trained MUST have a swim diaper on with elastic at the legs and waist. If swimmers have long hair it should be tied back so it will not get in their face during lessons.

OBSERVATION- We encourage parents to be active participants in their child's learning process. but we also ask for you to keep your presence during swim lessons to a minimum. Swim Lessons are a perfect time for your child to explore their independence and confidence in a safe environment. There are certain instances where your presence can detract from your child's ability to learn. We ask that you remain along pool walls/fences and approximately 10-12 feet away on beaches.

MISSED CLASSES - Make-ups are only held for classes canceled by the POA for bad weather and if we can find a make up time. We do not offer make-up classes for classes you have missed.

COMMUNICATION - Please sign up for Remind. This can be done 2 different ways.

Water acclimation is specially built for children who are not ready to swim without their parent(s). Throughout the session, the child transitions between the parent and instructor to allow the child to learn to listen to the instructor, become comfortable in the water, and safely explore movements in the water. A parent or guardian is required in the water with the child. Parents/Guardians will assist in teaching basic swimming skills.

2 Year Olds

- Integrating arm action, leg action, and rhythmic breathing in back and front glides
- Developing forward movement on the front and the back for 10-15 yards
- Practicing skills and safety techniques in deep water

Ages 5 and older (swimmers that are in between lessons and swim team)

This stage develops stroke technique in front crawl and back crawl. Water safety is reinforced through treading water. If the students are ready, instructors may introduce elementary backstroke which is the basics for breaststroke kick. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Developing the front crawl and back crawl 15-25 yards.
- · Introducing components of the breaststroke. (elementary backstroke)
- · Practicing safety techniques in deep water.
