BOOK YOUR BEACH/POOL PARTY

"Off Season" Dates: February - April and October - December can be booked NOW at the POA Office.

"In Season" Dates: May 1 - September 30 can be booked starting March 2nd.

All dues, including 2024, must be paid in full in order to book a party (off & in season dates).

Bathrooms are not guaranteed for any reservation.

Parties require 2 payments, \$100 refundable deposit if rules are followed and garbage removed. \$50 non-refundable fee for all parties. Payments can be made in only cash or check.

2023 Income Tax Information

The portion of dues applied to Real Estate Tax are deductible. For 2023, the amount is \$65.93 for Homeowners and \$16.48 for Lot Owners.

-Approved Board Meeting minutes from January 17, 2024.

-HOUSE OPS: Approved motion to pay for approved deck repair (motion #6) from the January 17, 2024 Board meeting from the Equalization Fund up to \$13,387.22.

-BEACH: Approved motion to hire Garden State Laboratories to test the water at our four lake sites and Drum Pool for the 2024 summer season at a cost of \$5,095.00 Money will come from line 503.21. This will overspend the line by \$95.

-BEACH: Approved motion to hire Garden State Laboratories to test the water at the Circus Pool for the 2024 summer season at a cost of \$1,600.00. Split 75/25 with CC/Camp (\$1,200 CC/Camp / \$400 POA line 503.21). This will overspend the POA line 503.21 by \$400.

-COMPUTER: Approved motion to renew our TOPS ONE membership management software subscription in the amount of \$1,537.54 per month, or \$18,450.48 per year. This is a 2-year contract renewal. Monies to come from line 513.09.



Mandatory Winter PFD Wear Campaign

New Regulation 13:82-1.4(f): Starting this November, no owner or operator of a recreational vessel less than 26 feet, including rowboats, canoes, kayaks, and stand-up paddleboards shall permit its operation between November 1st and May 1st, unless each person on board such vessel is wearing a securely fastened United States Coast Guard-approved wearable personal flotation device of an appropriate size while such vessel is underway. A person inside the cabin of a cabin vessel shall be exempt from this requirement.

- Boat size: length and width
- NJ Boat Registration, Boat Safety Certificate, NJ Trailer Registration, and if handicap space is required, the Disability ID

Boating Rules and Regulations

All Dues and fines must be paid in full to obtain a White Meadow Lake 2024 Boat Tag.

- NJ DMV BOAT REGISTRATION & BOAT SAFETY CERTIFICATE are required for GAS & ELECTRIC-powered boats to apply for a boat tag.
- BOAT, TRAILER & MOTOR SIZE- Boat & Trailer Length & Width are required. Maximum boat length-16 ft. Maximum Horse Power- 9.9HP.
- ONLY 2 BOATS PER RACK arc allowed.
- OCCUPY DATE- Assigned space(s) must be occupied on May 28th for both dock and land.
- Spaces not occupied on May 28th may be reassigned upon a resident's request for the vacant space. The office will contact the vacant space holder to advise them reassignment will be done, if after one week the space is not occupied. Extenuating circumstances will be considered if reported to the office.
- NO Waiting List will be maintained.
- \bullet Residents may SWAP SPACES after notifying the office and obtaining a replacement boat tag for the new space assigned.
- BOAT TAGS must be displayed or POA Security may padlock the boat until the proper tag is visible.
- HANDICAP accessible boat spaces will be available at all locations. A NJ state-issued Handicap ID is required.
- CLEAN both your boat and trailer after it has been in another body of water before putting in back into WML.
- REMOVAL DATES All Boats and Trailers must be removed from WML property no later than November 4th or the resident will incur a \$100 fine per boat, in addition to a \$10 penalty per boat per day.
