### COMMITTEE NEWS Lake Committee

The Lake Committee is excited to sponsor two courses this summer, one for Sailing and the other for Motor Boating Safety – which will provide the mandatory NJ boating certificate required to legally operate a motorboat in the state. Look for details in the newsletters and online. Lake water testing has begun with excellent results in terms of water clarity (average of 8 feet) and low algae and weed levels. We will be keeping a close eye on plant growth as temperatures increase and will treat as needed with low dose herbicides approved as safe for humans and animals. Happy Swimming, Boating & Fishing!
