July Board Meeting

- Approved Board Minutes from June 15, 2022
- Motion to spend up to \$100,000 for replacing the fencing & any other equipment (ie: nets/posts) from Equalization Fund. This motion is contingent on the ballot question passing. Carried
- Application for Household Membership (3). 2 Pass 1 Fail.
- Motion to appropriate \$130,000 to the Capital Improvement Fund from surplus cash. Carried.
- Motion to transfer \$25,000 from POA budget line 542.01 into the Capital Improvement Fund. Carried
- Motion to transfer \$25,000 from POA budget line 542.02 into the Sinking Fund. Carried
- Motion to transfer \$75,000 from Country Club cash into the Country Club Reserve Fund. Carried
- Motion to approve Preschool salary increases as discussed in closed caucus. Money to come from Preschool budget line 5101. Carried
- FYI: Purchased a pool tank from Pelican Sport Center Inc for the Drum Pool at a cost of \$1,492.74. Money to come from 50308, this will overspend the line.
- Motion to hire A-Better Fence Co. to repair fencing at Beach 1. Monies to come from line 503.09 & to be reimbursed from insurance payment. Not to exceed \$2,200. Carried
- Motion to hire A-Better Fence Co. to cut a Fence Gate into the Drum Pool fencing by the pump/filter equipment. Cost not to exceed \$2,020 and monies to come from line 503.09. Carried
- Motion to pay Jimmy Concrete \$3,967.25 for the work at the Circus Pool. This work included: Draining the pool to pressure test all lines to determine leak. Repair of leak found under pump house. Acid wash cleaning of pool. Refill pool & balance chemicals for inspection. Also, correction of plumbing in pump house. Cost to be split between beach line 503.08 - \$991.81 (25%) this will overspend the line & Camp (75%) \$2,975.44. Carried
- Motion to pay Jimmy Concrete for clean-out of Drum Pool related to renovation of Pool Decking by contractor Guscus. Money to come from holdback money from Guscus contract as approved by the motion from the Equalization Fund question. Total amount to be paid to Jimmy Concrete \$2,260. Carried
- Motion to pay Jimmy Concrete for the opening & servicing of Drum Pool & repair of pumps / valves / chlorinators & chemicals supplied for process. Total cost \$4,251.82 - to be applied as follows: \$1,250 from line 503.20 (pool opening/closing) / \$1,648 from line 503.08 (repair /replace equipment) and will overspend the line / \$1,353.82 from line 503.22 (chemicals). Carried
- FYI: Purchased T-Shirts from DMC Promotions for the swim team at a cost of \$1,038.16. Money to come from 501.06.

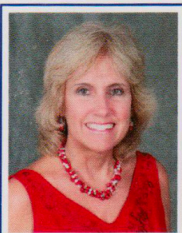

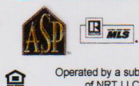

WEEKEND HOSTESS/HOST: Open the building three hours prior to the event, introduce yourself to the caterer, introduce yourself to the host of the party, make sure the air conditioning or heat is working properly, help the bartender get ready and the bartender during and after the party, make sure the bridal party is comfortable in the bridal room, secure the bar and doors after all guests leave. Other various duties as required. This position is for Events only that are held Friday, Saturdays and Sundays.

SECURITY GUARD: Provide a security presence at all POA facilities/property and within the Clubhouse. Assist members by contacting emergency personnel when necessary. Inform Site Manager of vandalism and any irregularities in a timely manner. Multiple shifts needed both day and evenings.

BARTENDER: Must be available to work all shifts, Thursday through Monday. Bartender experience required.

PART-TIME BUS BOY/GIRL: Bus Boy / Gal Part-time SEASONAL -The Bus Boys/Gals primary responsibility is to clean up the Club House Deck, lawn, and Gold Lounge when the Bar is open, including clearing tables of discarded food, cups, & bottles, They are also responsible to empty garbage cans and to place trash in tied plastic bags before placing in dumpster, place compacted recyclables in recycling dumpster, bring ice from the kitchen to the Bartenders. **WORKING HOURS:**

The hours are likely to be Thursday from 7 pm to 10 pm and Friday and Saturday evenings from 7 pm to 1 am through the month of September.

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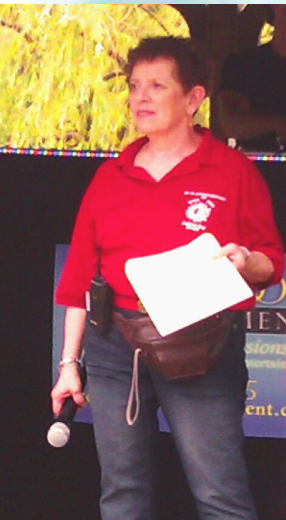
