- 1. The beer lines were cleaned on April 30th.
- 2. The first Food Truck Friday event was well attended notwithstanding the rain squall that we endured.
- 3. Laura and Kurry are filling in for Patrizia while she is out for 6-8 weeks.
- 4. Beach party: Each year we cut back on what we bring to better manage inventory that must be transported twice and then kept cold. We will bring less this year.
- 5. There will be some necessary incremental price increases implemented. We will request some pricing clarifications from Patrizia.
- 6. We voted to increase Stella, Blue Moon, Tito's and flavored Stoli by \$1.00 to align with recent price increases. Vote was 9 0
- 7. We will schedule the Festival Day bartender meeting in the coming weeks.
- 8. We will use the Tiffany Bar and Gold Bar during Festival Day weekend. No outside bar. This will allow for a more complete selection and full bar availability.
- 9. Bar and Rental was left in a difficult position concerning Food Truck Fridays in early May with the arrangements being dropped. Bar & Rental became aware with just over a week before the first event. Patrizia, our Banquet Manager, reached out to all of the vendors, who told us that they had not heard from anyone in several weeks. Patrizia let them know that moving forward she was their contact person. Patrizia had put everything in order with all of the vendors in

a compressed timeframe fortunately as the Food Truck events had already been advertised. The town was very helpful with the necessary permits.

10. Our treasurer alerted us that approximately \$13,000 in deferred income was not accounted for in the B & R profit report recently published. This revision reduces the year over year reduction in revenue by 50%. There are several other factors still to be reviewed including lower sale volumes, lower ticket sales due to event saturation, raised wages and higher inventory costs, etc. Some trends reach back into 2024 and will be reviewed as well.
