NEW JERSEY NATURAL GAS
On Monday, November 10, the Civic Affairs Health & Safety Committee sponsored a meeting regarding New Jersey Natural Gas which was attended by over 60 residents. Some of the key information which the residents received included information which let us know that there are currently rebates and how to obtain them should you decide to convert to Natural Gas. In order to obtain the higher rebates any furnace must have a minimum 92% energy efficiency. It was suggested that every homeowner considering conversion have an energy audit done. New Jersey Natural Gas is also offering a 0% interest loan which would be paid directly to them through your monthly bill, an application needs to be complete prior to December 31, 2014 as this is the current application deadline. The sources for the rebates are NJNG (New Jersey Natural Gas) and NJCEP (New Jersey Clean Energy Program).

A map of the proposed schedule for the installation of the gas lines was also distributed. We were also informed that if we were on a particular street which might be scheduled out longer than we anticipated, a number of the neighbors could contact NJNG and ask how many homes it would take to speed up installation for their street.



## December Fish Special MUSKELLUNGE

How to identify a Muskellunge:

"The Muskellunge is found in cool water habitats. It has soft fins with short bases and dorsal and anal fins are set far back on the body. It has a forward facing mouth with a characteristic "duck-bill" shape and a pointed snout. The lower jaw protrudes beyond the upper with jaws and other mouth bones bearing large teeth. Its body shape is tubular and it has small scales that are present on the head and body."

#### FISH TALES

As we get into the holiday season and winter weather is in full swing, it is a great time to reflect on the past wml fishing season and prepare yourself for the new year to come. It is

critical to service your rods and reels and look over your tackle. This is the best time of year to stock up on your new gear for 2015!




