November Board Meeting

- Approved 2nd Annual Meeting minutes from October 12, 2025.
- Approved Board Meeting minutes from October 15, 2025
- BOARD: Approved motion to hire SouthData to process & mail our 2026 dues statements at a cost up to \$2,700. Money to come from line 513.01.
- BOARD: Approved motion to set the 2026 POA dues at \$990 with an offset from 2025 surplus of \$50,000 making the final dues amount \$970 per home & \$242.50 per lot.
- BOARD: Application for Household Membership (1)
- SENIORS: Approved motion to hire Vanderhoof & Sons busing at a cost not to exceed \$2,600 to supply busing back and forth for the Woodlock Pines senior trip.
- ATHLETICS FYI: Purchased a volleyball slider attachment system with a net for Beach 1 from Volleyball USA.com at a cost of \$1,113.04. This includes tax and shipping. Money to come from line 501.03.
- HOUSE ACTIVITIES FYI: Hired Stage Fright Band to perform at the 2025 NYE event at a cost of \$850.00. Money to come from Country Club line 5099.










Here are some pictures from the Seniors trip to the Shore Club on October 22, 2025. Thank you to everyone who joined us!

- NON-REFUNDABLE \$100.00 deposit and \$25 registration fee are due at time of registration.
- Payment plans are available
- A 3% convenience fee will be added for payments made by credit/debit cards run in the office.
- Parent must sign a waiver of liability for bodily injuries at time of registration, as well as provide your child's birth certificate if they have not been previously enrolled
- POA dues must be current
- Any withdrawal of a child from a class MUST be done by a written letter to the POA office
- First half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before July 25th, 2026. If the first half payment is not received, the child will not be allowed to start the first day of school.
- Second half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before November 21st, 2026. If second half payment is not received by November 21st, a \$50.00 late fee will be assessed.



Auditing

Purpose is to advise the Board on management & accounting procedures for the POA, Camp & Country Club. In this connection, it may conduct surveys of established methods of audit & administration. Meetings as needed.

Bar & Rental

Responsible for the operation of the Lounge and Gold & Tiffany Bars. Oversees the guidelines for the rental of ballrooms. Meetings 1st Wednesday of the month at 7:00 pm.

Beach

Develop policies for the beaches and recreation facilities located there, as well as the parking areas. This committee has jurisdiction over the concession buildings. Meetings 2nd Wednesday of the month at 6:30 pm.

Camp

The CC operates a summer day camp for the children of White Meadow Lake, ages 5 to 15. The camp program includes swimming, softball, arts & crafts, soccer, basketball, performing arts, boating, hiking, and quiet games. Meetings 2nd Wednesday of the month at 7:30 pm.

Civic Affairs

Informs the Board and the general public of actions, problems and issues which affect WML residents. Meetings 3rd Monday of the month at 7pm.

Festival Days

Conducts our annual weekend of fun and entertainment for the entire community and their families and friends. Meetings 1st Thursday of the month at 7:30 pm (Feb - Aug).

House Activities

Coordinates social events primarily for adults. Includes shows and events throughout the year and an Annual New Year's Eve Party. Meetings 1st Wednesday of the month at 6:00 pm

House Operations/Maint

Maintains and operates the Clubhouse and adjoining grounds, entrance triangle and Seneca triangle, and is responsible for the overall upkeep of POA properties. Meetings 1st Wednesday of the month at 8:30 pm

Insurance

Advises the Board of Directors on all insurance matters, reviews and monitors insurance coverage and costs, as well as insurance industry markets and trends. Meetings as needed.

Lake/Lake Reclamation

Responsible for establishing rules and regulations pertaining to boating, fishing, and safety of the public. Responsible for treatment of the Lake water, fish stocking, and repair and replacement of POA docks. Approves installation of new privately owned docks. Researches and implements long-term Lake water renovation projects. Meetings 1st Thursday of the month at 7:30 pm.

Legal & By-Laws

Responsible for advising the Board of Directors on all proposed changes or amendments to our Constitution and Admin Guidelines.

Meetings 3rd Monday of the month at 7:30 pm.

Marketing & Communications

This new committee tackles many issues including social media and the marketing of all aspects of the White Meadow Lake community. Meetings 3rd Monday of the month at 6:30 pm.

Planning

Involved in both long and short-term planning for the future growth of the WML community. Meetings 1st Wednesday of the month at 8:00 pm.

Security

Oversees and develops policies for the security of the POA common properties. Meetings 1st Wednesday of the month at 7:30 pm.

Seniors

Conducts the activities of the WML Seniors Friendship Club which offers Senior Citizens (55 years +) bi-monthly social and educational activities. Committee meets 2nd Thursday of the month at 12:30 pm. Club meets 2nd & 4th Thursdays of the month at 1:30 pm.

Technology

Monitor and maintain our technology as needed. Meetings as needed.

Women's Club
