- **A-Field Basketball Courts**
  - Waiting on quotes to reseal the basketball courts
- **Sport Courts**
  - Evan Trisler suggested getting temporary netting that people can bring and hang for badminton and other sports on the pickleball courts when courts are not being used
    - Jen Cordas suggested that the multi-sport court is more appropriate for something like that
    - Idea of temporary rubber mat lines that can be laid down on sport court area to use to allow pickleball and tennis courts to be left open
  - We have hockey nets at the multi-purpose court now. Thank you, Erin Macellaro, for lacing the nets!
  - Looking into doing multi-colored lines in that area next year to allow for multiple sports.

### OLD BUSINESS

- Review of last meeting's minutes
- Parking at the salt dome is not WML property. We will look into parking options when the town project is finished. The town will be paving the road when done.
- 2 benches were purchased for the multi-sport court, should arrive the week of 9/9/24.
- USA Volleyball event at the A-field on 9/22/24. 8<sup>th</sup> grade and younger. 12-2pm
- Estimate for the B field fencing, quote is \$5,320.29. Pat has the specs. Hoping to get it done before softball season next year. At least one other bid will be needed.
- Sealcoating quote, \$5,710, probably a project for the spring. Glen will follow up with Bob Hale for a quote.
- The blacktop volleyball court at the A-Field will be turned into a second full size basketball court
- Charlie is looking into solutions to the lighting issues and a rebate from JCPL for lighting at Beach 1. There are multiple lighting concerns around the lake. Volleyball asked for a generator for temporary lighting, there is no budget for that this year. The lighting professional will assess the sport and situation and make recommendations.
- Jodie Nichols has experience in lighting and will get a quote for the volleyball courts at Beach 1
- Discussion re:railroad
- Hub Lakes – Michelle Cromwell, Flynn and Biddleman did a great job hosting Hubs swimming championships. Hubs Lakes is looking for Volleyball chairperson. Hub Lakes Tennis 1 day round robin, Joanne K will head it up. Also looking for a coach for Pickleball, Carrie Caruana. Dani will bring it back to Hub Lakes to find out interest.  
Also, as a reminder please ask for a rosters to make sure everyone playing lives within the boundaries. Discussion of houseguest's rules in Hub Lakes

### NEW BUSINESS

- Discussion of the tennis/pickleball/multisport court gates. The request was made for all the gates to be unlocked every day.
- A windscreen update was asked for.
- A request was made for a path from basketball courts to the multisport court for kids on bikes.
- A suggestion was made for a biking/running path around the A-Field. Sarah LaLicata will research the possibilities. It has been discussed in the past and it was very expensive, and EPA restrictions will have to be considered.
- What will happen after tennis attendants are done for the season. Maintenance will unlock/lock courts daily. Security will be around and check in when available.
- A concern regarding people crashing into the fence was brought up.
- Lighting on tennis/pickleball courts needs to be adjusted so it's not aiming right in people's eyes. The electrician will be contacted to see about getting it adjusted.

- There is a new interest in pick-up Badminton. The court is the same size as pickleball and the players could possibly zip tie a net to the pickleball net. Talk to Daryl or Glen regarding picking a night so not to interfere with planned events. Post in newsletter to let people aware.
- A request was made for adjustable volleyball nets, men and women have different height requirements

  - check badges, sign guests in, squeegee courts
  - limit 90 minute games for doubles
  - sign-in book should have time stamps
  - should have all agreed upon rules printed out for attendant to follow (check list)
  - need to get signage with basic rules. Security number should be listed as well. Can have a QR code with more detailed rules.
  - consulted rules that we put in May newsletter
  - committee voted to approve rules about time limits that Jen presented which she will email to Glen
3. Ideas for use - pickle ball clinics, Hub Lakes tournaments
4. Punch list items to discuss with contractor

- Swim season kicked off tonight
- Need to submit a motion to the board to order new equipment for Hub Lakes
- Women's volleyball requested money for new shirts
- Our track team had the largest participation in years. Still awaiting final results from meet.
  - Dom Dixon broke the Hub Lakes record for the Shot Put
- Men's and Women's Horseshoes seasons have kicked off
- Tennis Courts
  - New Lighting
    - Stu Nemiroff came to say that the lights are not properly positioned right now.
    - Committee will follow up with electrician to discuss. Electrician said they will come back to do final re-alignment once courts are completed.
  - Glen and Daryl walked courts today. From what they can see, they are looking good. The drainage was good after the last rainstorm.
  - Court paving needs 30 days to cure before surfacing can go down. There is a possibility that temporary lines can be painted in the meantime.
  - Discussed some idea for court scheduling/sign ups during peak hours.
- Budget
  - We want to order equipment for multi-sport court from this year's budget (501.02)
  - About \$1,500 to reach goal for AED at A-Field. Possible cornhole tournament to raise money.
  - May need to order a new basketball backboard for Paved Surface at A-Field this year (501.02) if we cannot successfully move the current one. Roughly \$2,800
  - Suggested increasing equipment line by 5% to keep up with inflation
  - Increasing Salaries from \$20k to \$25k. Will need to hire tennis attendants again next year.
  - Would like to change name of 501.10 to "Maintain Tennis/Multi-Purpose Courts)
  - 501.12,
    - Would like to get a quote to get new fencing along baselines on Softball field closest to pavilion and Circus Pool before proposing a line item number.

She wants a copy of the plan if possible.
